Robert Ferré has always liked visiting sacred sites and working with his hands. Eventually, he found a way to combine these two loves: building labyrinths. Since 1996, Robert has devoted his life to being a full-time labyrinth creator and director of his company Labyrinth Enterprises.

Robert's work in organizing labyrinth conferences in St. Louis in 1997 and 1998 led to the creation of the Labyrinth Society. This international group serves those who work with labyrinths around the world.

The two-day intensive training seminar that Robert offers gives people with an interest in labyrinths an opportunity to understand more about sacred geometry and hands-on experience in learning how to create labyrinths.



Robert has lectured in the United States, Canada, England, and France. He lives in a suburb of St. Louis with his wife Ruth Hanna.
